This first important project reminds students some basics of Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign. Students should have taken and passed Design Technology, so this should be a review. As with any tool, practice makes perfect.

This project asks each student to follow steps in their own time in (and out of) class via the Adobe Express page linked below. The page includes links and videos to help students; however, students should ask professor for help when needed!

- The website will sometimes refresh itself while you're working. Don't worry! When it does this, it goes back to the top of the page. Just scroll down to where you were.
- **DO NOT SKIP OVER** the section that reviews file types and how Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign work individually and together.
- The *very informal* videos of the professor were filmed a couple of years ago; therefore, the software's interface may look slightly different after multiple Adobe updates. The videos are also not necessary to understand the directions, as each step is written on the page, so ignore them if it's too confusing.
